
• 7461\_Fruits

The small appliqués are stitched out as individual pieces and can be hung on an existing necklace or made into earrings.

## Fabric / Notions

- Imitation leather or remnants of tarpaulin fabric
- Remnants of cotton fabrics
- Any necklace
- Textile adhesive
- Open jewellery rings, min. 8 mm in diameter
- Embroidery accessories
- BERNINA embroidery machine

## Designs

Work out the appliqués on the imitation leather or the tarpaulin fabric.

Cut the fruit just next to the satin stitch.

Stick the fruit wrong side on wrong side together.

Using pointed embroidery scissors or similar, pierce a hole within the fruit close to the satin stitch. Insert a jewellery ring into each hole and arrange the fruit on your necklace as you please.
